A, §8 and affected by §§9 to 11, is amended to read: 10 6. Salary; expenses. A board member is entitled to a per diem of \$100 per day 11 \$200. Members of the board receive their actual, necessary, cash expenses while on 12 official business of the board. 13 **SUMMARY** 14 15 This bill increases the compensation for Workers' Compensation Board members to

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\$200 per day.
