1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §843, sub-§4, ¶D, as amended by PL 2007, c. 261, §1 and c. 388, §3, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
4 5	D. A child, domestic partner's child, parent, domestic partner, sibling or spouse with a serious health condition;
6 7	Sec. 2. 26 MRSA §843, sub-§4, ¶F, as enacted by PL 2007, c. 388, §5, is amended to read:
8 9 10 11	F. The death or serious health condition of the employee's spouse, domestic partner, parent, sibling or child if the spouse, domestic partner, parent, sibling or child as a member of the state military forces, as defined in Title 37-B, section 102, or the United States Armed Forces, including the National Guard and Reserves, dies or incurs a serious health condition while on active duty.

14 15	This bill allows an employee to take family medical leave for a sibling with a serious health condition or who dies.
