Amend the amendment in Part A in section 27 on page 89 in the 2nd initiative in the first line (page 89, line 11 in amendment) by striking out the following: "to one provider per district" and inserting the following: 'in each of the 8 districts'

Amend the amendment in Part A in section 27 on page 91 in the 3rd initiative in the first line (page 91, line 23 in amendment) by striking out the following: "to one provider per district" and inserting the following: 'in each of the 8 districts'

Amend the amendment in Part A in section 27 on page 92 in the first initiative in the first line (page 92, line 1 in amendment) by striking out the following: "to one provider per district" and inserting the following: 'in each of the 8 districts'

Amend the amendment in Part A in section 27 on page 97 in the first initiative in the first line (page 97, line 1 in amendment) by striking out the following: "to one provider per district" and inserting the following: 'in each of the 8 districts'

Amend the amendment in Part A in section 28 on page 141 in the first initiative in the first line (page 141, line 2 in amendment) by striking out the following: "to one provider per district" and inserting the following: 'in each of the 8 districts'

SUMMARY

This amendment requires the consolidation of adult mental health crisis services into 8 locations instead of 7 as proposed in Committee Amendment "A."
