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#### **SUMMARY**

This amendment replaces the bill with a resolve. It adopts a moratorium for 18 months on the processing or issuance of new submerged lands leases for commercial projects by the Department of Conservation, Bureau of Parks and Lands and aquaculture leases by the Department of Marine Resources. During the moratorium, the Town of Old Orchard Beach and the City of Saco may convene a working group to examine municipal boundaries, regulatory jurisdictions and parameters for future development in Saco Bay. If a working group is convened, the Director of the State Planning Office within the Executive Department, or the director's designee, should be invited to participate. In addition, representatives from the Department of Marine Resources, the Department of Conservation, Bureau of Parks and Lands and any other departments determined necessary as well as municipal representatives from the Town of Scarborough and the City of Biddeford should be invited to participate. If a group is convened, it is authorized to submit a report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over state and local government matters no later than January 15, 2009, and the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over state and local government matters is authorized to submit legislation to the First Regular Session of the 124th Legislature.
