- 9 COMMITTEE-AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1586, L.D. 2220, Bill, "An Act To Aid 10 Victims of Identity Theft in Securing a Police Report and To Aid Victims in Court 11 Proceedings When Their Identities Have Been Stolen and Falsely Used"
- 12 Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

13 'An Act To Aid Victims of Identity Theft in Securing a Police Report'

14 Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the 15 following:

16 'Mandate preamble. This measure requires one or more local units of government 17 to expand or modify activities so as to necessitate additional expenditures from local 18 revenues but does not provide funding for at least 90% of those expenditures. Pursuant to 19 the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21, 2/3 of all of the members elected to 20 each House have determined it necessary to enact this measure.'

- 21 Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2.
- 22 SUMMARY

This amendment deletes section 2 of the bill, which proposed a procedure to obtain a finding of factual innocence when a person's identity is stolen and falsely used in a court prosecution. It adds a mandate preamble and a fiscal note.
