The maximum bet for licensed games of chance, including card games in which bets are placed per hand or per deal, is \$1 for any one chance, hand or deal Licensed card games that award part or all of the entry fees paid to participate as prize money and in which no money or thing of value is wagered except for the entry fee are limited to a \$5 daily entry fee and no more than 40 players at any one time at any one location.

25 26 27 28 29 30	This amendment clarifies existing statutes regarding licensed card games for which the entry fee is the wager and card games in which wagers are placed per hand or per deal. The amendment retains from the bill an increase in the maximum entry fee for card games from \$1 to \$5 and an increase in the license fee for these card games from \$7.50 to \$30 per year. The amendment also limits the number of players at these card games to 40.

Increasing the fee for a license issued to an organization to operate a game of cards from \$7.50 to \$30 per calendar year will result in increased dedicated revenue to the Department of Public Safety of \$675 annually beginning in fiscal year 2008-09.
