COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 866, L.D. 2239, "Resolve, To Name a Road in Dexter after Harold Alfond"

Amend the resolve by inserting after the title and before section 1 the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the Legislature finds that it is important to recognize and remember, without delay, Harold Alfond, a great businessman and philanthropist of the State of Maine, with the designation of part of State Route 7 as the Harold Alfond Memorial Highway; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

Amend the resolve by adding before the summary the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation takes effect when approved.'

SUMMARY

This amendment adds an emergency preamble and emergency clause to the resolve.
