SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1602, L.D. 2241, "Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Portions of Chapter 1, Open Water and Ice Fishing Regulations, a Major Substantive Rule of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the first indented paragraph after the title (page 1, lines 12 to 16 in amendment).

SUMMARY

This amendment removes language that requires that the rule that designates state waters that contain Artic Charr as State Heritage Fish Waters be amended to remove from the proposed list Black Lake in Aroostook County, Rainbow Lake in Piscataquis County and Floods Pond in Hancock County but allows final adoption of the rule without hearings.
