COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1627, L.D. 2264, Bill, "An Act To Encourage Energy Conservation by the Maine State Housing Authority Pursuant to the State Government Evaluation Act Review"

Amend the bill in section 3 in paragraph CC in the 2nd line (page 2, line 8 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "participate" the following: 'with resources derived from sources except the conservation program fund under Title 35-A, section 3211-A, subsection 5.'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that, in carrying out its authority to support and participate in markets that reward energy conservation, the Maine State Housing Authority may use resources derived from any source except the conservation program fund established by the Public Utilities Commission pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 35-A, section 3211-A, subsection 5.
