1 **Sec. 1. In-person absentee voting prohibited on the day prior to election**
2 **day. Resolved:** That notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 21-A, section
3 753-B, subsection 8 a person may not vote by absentee ballot in the presence of the clerk
4 on November 3, 2008, but a person may still obtain a ballot by written request to vote
5 outside of the clerk's office.
