1	'Sec. 17. 30-A MRSA §864, sub-§4-B is enacted to read:
12 13 14	4-B. Petition; referendum on county budget. The citizens of the county may file a petition to send a budget approved pursuant to subsection 4 to referendum in accordance with this section.
5	A. A petition to send a budget to referendum must:
6 .7	(1) Be submitted to the county commissioners no later than 45 days after the budget has been adopted;
8 9 20	(2) Contain the signatures and legal addresses of voters in the county equal in number to at least 10% of the total vote cast in the county for Governor at the last preceding gubernatorial election; and
21 22 23 24 25 26 27	(3) Be submitted to the appropriate municipal registrar for certification by 5 p.m. on the 10th day before the petition must be filed with the county commissioners or, if the 10th day is a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, by 5 p.m. on the next day that is not a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday. The registrar must complete the certification of the petitions and return them to the circulators or their agents within 5 days of the date on which the petitions were submitted, Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays excepted.
28 29	B. No later than 45 days after receipt of a petition, the county commissioners shall schedule a countywide referendum on the budget.
30 31	C. If the voters do not approve the budget, the county shall prepare another budget in accordance with this section.'
