Whereas,** acts and resolves of the Legislature do not 2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

3 Whereas, this legislation provides funds to restore positions that were eliminated in 4 Public Law 2007, chapter 539, which takes effect June 30, 2008; and

5 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within 6 the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as 7 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 8 therefore,

9 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

10 Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.
