10 Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 2-A by inserting at the end the
11 following new sentence: 'For purposes of this subsection, the possession by an applicant
12 for 20 or more consecutive years of a valid license issued under this chapter constitutes
13 valid documentary evidence of legal presence in the United States.'

14 Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 11 and inserting the following:

15 'Sec. 11. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and
16 allocations are made.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment provides that possession of a valid driver's license for 20 or more consecutive years constitutes valid documentary evidence of legal presence. It is assumed that these individuals, under this legislation, would not need to visit a branch office to show such documentation. Therefore, the fiscal year 2008-09 allocation could be reduced by \$719,174 as a result of decreased traffic through the branch offices.
