9	1669, L.D. 2309, Bill, "An Act To Enhance the Security of State Credentials"			
10	Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 11 and inserting the following:			
11	'Sec. 11. Contingent effective date. This Act does not take effect until the State			
12	has received sufficient federal funding to fully cover the State's cost of compliance with			
13	the federal REAL ID Act of 2005. The Secretary of State, in consultation with			
14	appropriate agencies of State Government, shall determine the costs to the State of			

15 implementation of compliance. The Secretary of State shall provide notice to the 16 Secretary of the Senate, the Clerk of the House and the Revisor of Statutes when this 17 contingency has been met.'

SUMMARY

19 This amendment places a contingent effective date on the bill to delay 20 implementation until after federal funding is received to fully cover the State's cost of 21 compliance with the federal REAL ID Act of 2005. The Secretary of State is required to 22 consult with other state agencies to determine the cost of compliance. This amendment 23 also removes the appropriations and allocations section from the committee amendment.

This amendment makes the effective date of this legislation contingent upon receiving Federal funding sufficient to fully cover the cost to the State of complying with the federal REAL ID Act of 2005. It eliminates the Highway Fund revenue of \$3,051,375 and the Highway Fund allocation of \$1,528,944.
