SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1677, L.D. 2318, "Resolve, To Appoint Members to and Establish Terms for the Workers' Compensation Board"

Amend the resolve in section 1 in subsection 1 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "a list of no fewer than 12 names" and inserting the following: '3 lists of no fewer than 4 names'

SUMMARY

This amendment specifies that the employer and labor organizations designated to submit names of proposed board members each submit 3 lists of no fewer than 4 names, rather than one list of no fewer than 12 names as proposed in the bill.
