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

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 724, "Joint Order Requiring the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services To Review Eligibility for and Transitioning of the Maine Care Program"

Amend the order by inserting at the end of the first paragraph the following: 'The committee must complete its work in no more than 3 meetings held during the interim between the First Regular Session of the 123rd Legislature and the Second Regular Session of the 123rd Legislature.'
