13 14	'Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1304, sub-§1, ¶E, as amended by PL 2005, c. 577, §18, is further amended to read:
15 16	E. Unless the permittee is operating a motorcycle or moped, the permit requires the permittee to be accompanied by a licensed operator who:
17 18	(1) Has held a valid license for the immediately preceding at least 2 consecutive years;
9	(2) Is at least 20 years of age;
20	(3) Is occupying a seat beside the driver; and
21	(4) Is licensed to operate the class vehicle operated by the permittee.
22	The accompanying operator must adhere to all restrictions applied to the license
23	when functioning as the permittee's accompanying operator. A person who meets the
24	conditions of subparagraphs (2), (3) and (4) whose license was canceled or suspended
24 25	for physical, mental or emotional reasons within the immediately preceding 2
26	consecutive years may act as an accompanying operator pursuant to this paragraph
27	with the approval of the Secretary of State.'

.9	This amendment, which replaces the bill, requires the person acting as the
0	accompanying operator for a permit holder to have held a valid license for at least 2
.1	vears
