Application. Resolved: That the rules as amended pursuant to this 18 resolve apply to an application for a license as a pastoral counselor filed from April 1, 19 2009 to June 1, 2009. Application materials that have been previously submitted to the 20 Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, Office of Licensing and 21 Registration, Board of Counseling Professionals Licensure are not required to be 22 resubmitted for new applications during this time period.' 23 **SUMMARY** 24 This amendment requires the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, 25 Office of Licensing and Registration, Board of Counseling Professionals Licensure to 26 amend its rules governing licensed pastoral counselors to allow the board to approve 27 educational requirements in a nonaccredited program determined equivalent by the board. 28 This amendment also removes the provision requiring retroactive application of this 29 resolve and provides instead that the rule changes apply only for applications for 30 licensure as a pastoral counselor filed from April 1, 2009 to June 1, 2009. It also 31 provides that any application materials that have been previously submitted to the Board



of Counseling Professionals Licensure are not required to be resubmitted for new applications during this time period.
