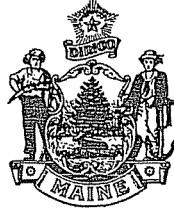

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §1154** is enacted to read:

3 **§1154. Sale of signs prohibited**

4 A person may not sell or offer to sell a sign that had been placed by the State, a  
5 county or a municipality on a highway or street. A person who violates this section  
6 commits a Class E crime.

7 **SUMMARY**

8 This bill provides that a person may not sell or offer to sell a sign that had been  
9 placed by the State, a county or a municipality on a highway or street. A person who  
10 violates this provision commits a Class E crime.

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
