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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

26 policy, contract or certificate that provides coverage for services under this section may
27 contain provisions for maximum benefits and coinsurance and reasonable limitations,

30 Sec. 7. Application. The requirements of this Act apply to all policies, contracts and 31 certificates executed, delivered, issued for delivery, continued or renewed in this State on or 32 after January 1, 2010. For purposes of this Act, all contracts are deemed to be renewed no 33 later than the next yearly anniversary of the contract date.

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SUMMARY

This bill requires health insurance policies, contracts and certificates to provide coverage for diagnostic testing and screening for autism spectrum disorders. The provisions of this bill apply to all policies, contracts and certificates issued or renewed on or after January 1, 2010.
