3	This resolve is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
4	This resolve proposes to establish a study commission that would:
5 6 7	1. Review the various state and federal laws governing the confidentiality of personal information, including but not limited to laws governing the privacy of health records and financial information; and
8 9 10	2. Propose measures that strike an appropriate balance between an individual's interest in preserving privacy and the community's interest in preventing domestic violence.
