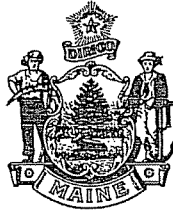

### An Act To Establish Native American Veterans Day

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §150-C** is enacted to read:

3 **§150-C. Native American Veterans Day**

4 The Governor annually shall issue a proclamation designating May 1st as Native  
5 American Veterans Day in remembrance of the courage and dedicated service of Native  
6 American members of the United States Armed Forces, and the Governor shall urge the  
7 people of the State to observe this day in suitable places and with appropriate ceremony and  
8 activity.

9 **SUMMARY**

10 This bill establishes May 1st of each year as Native American Veterans Day in the State.
