**An Act To Require the Secretary of State To Provide Notice of
License Revocation or Suspension by Certified Mail**

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2482, sub-§1**, as amended by PL 2001, c. 361, §33, is further
3 amended to read:

4 **1. Notification by Secretary of State.** Upon determining that a person is subject to
5 license suspension or revocation, the Secretary of State shall immediately notify the person,
6 in writing, of the license suspension or revocation. The notice:

7 A. Must be sent by certified mail to the last name and address provided under section
8 1407 or, if the person has not applied for a license, on record with the Secretary of State;

9 B. Must be sent by certified mail to the address provided in the report of the law
10 enforcement officer if that address differs from the address of record; or

11 C. May be served in hand.

12 **SUMMARY**

13 This bill requires the notice of license suspension or revocation mailed by the Secretary
14 of State to be done by certified mail.
