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## 1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2482, sub-§1, as amended by PL 2001, c. 361, §33, is further
 amended to read:

Notification by Secretary of State. Upon determining that a person is subject to
 license suspension or revocation, the Secretary of State shall immediately notify the person,
 in writing, of the license suspension or revocation. The notice:

- A. Must be sent <u>by certified mail</u> to the last name and address provided under section
  1407 or, if the person has not applied for a license, on record with the Secretary of State;
- 9 B. Must be sent <u>by certified mail</u> to the address provided in the report of the law 10 enforcement officer if that address differs from the address of record; or
- 11 C. May be served in hand.

## SUMMARY

13 This bill requires the notice of license suspension or revocation mailed by the Secretary 14 of State to be done by certified mail.
