1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §12001, sub-§1, as amended by PL 2007, c. 242, §1, is further amended to read:
- 1. Open night hunting season. Notwithstanding the night hunting prohibitions in section 11206-A, there is an open season for hunting coyotes at night in all counties of the State from January December 1st to June May 1st.

SUMMARY

This bill changes the coyote night hunting season from January 1st to June 1st to December 1st to May 1st each year.
