Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill includes ongoing Other Special Revenue Funds allocations of \$95,194 per year beginning in fiscal year 2009-10 for the Administration - Bureau of Labor Standards program within the Department of Labor to increase the amount that may be held in the Maine Wage Assurance Fund from its current annual allocation of \$104,806 to an annual allocation of \$200,000.
