Amend the amendment in section 3 in the last 2 lines (page 1, lines 35 and 36 in amendment) by striking out the following: ", including any necessary implementing legislation; and be it further" and inserting the following: "!

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 4.

This amendment removes authority for the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over taxation matters to submit a bill to the 125th Legislature.
