Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §13068-A, sub-§9, ¶A, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 655, Pt. B, §380 and affected by §422, is amended to read:

A. A person who violates this subsection commits a civil violation for which a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$500 may be adjudged.

Sec. 4. 12 MRSA §13068-A, sub-§13, ¶C, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 655, Pt. B, §380 and affected by §422, is amended to read:

C. The following penalties apply to violations of this subsection.

(1) A person who violates this subsection commits a civil violation for which a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$500 may be adjudged.

(2) A person who violates this subsection after having been adjudicated as having committed 3 or more civil violations under this Part within the previous 5-year period commits a Class E crime.'

SUMMARY

16 This amendment is a minority report. It changes the fine structure for certain 17 violations of watercraft operation laws from fines of not less than \$100 or more than \$500 18 to a minimum fine of \$500.
