COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 38, L.D. 89, Bill, "An Act To Amend the Laws Concerning Informal Conferences as Part of the Board of Licensure in Medicine's Disciplinary Proceedings"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in the 2nd blocked paragraph in the 3rd line (page 1, line 16 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "request" the following: 'and conduct'

Amend the bill in section 1 in the 2nd blocked paragraph in the 7th line (page 1, line 20 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "board" the following: 'or a subcommittee of the board'

Amend the bill in section 1 in the 2nd blocked paragraph in the 9th line (page 1, line 22 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "board" the following: 'or a subcommittee of the board'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the subcommittee of the Board of Licensure in Medicine is authorized to request and conduct an informal conference with the licensee.
