## **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

Revenue received from the sale of real estate in the unorganized territory will increase Other Special Revenue Funds in the Unorganized Territory Education and Services Fund and will be used to reduce future tax assessments in the unorganized territory. The amount of additional dedicated revenue will depend on the prices received at the time of sale.
