1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §19203-D, sub-§1, as reenacted by PL 1999, c. 512, Pt. B, §4 3 and affected by §§5 and 6, is repealed and the following enacted in its place: 4 1. Authorized release. When the person who is the subject of an HIV test 5 authorizes the release of medical information on a general medical information release form, the custodian of the medical record receiving the form may release any HIV 6 7 infection status information contained in the medical record. Release of HIV infection 8 status information pursuant to this subsection is not a violation of any of the 9 confidentiality provisions of this chapter. 10 **SUMMARY** 11 This bill allows the release of HIV infection status information when a person

11 This bill allows the release of HIV infection status information when a person 12 authorizes the release of general medical information and eliminates the requirement for a 13 specific authorization to be signed at the time a person receives the results of an HIV test.
