1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

A telephone utility may not include any line-item charge in a bill to a customer except a
line-item charge that represents an actual service requested by the customer or a line-item
charge that is specifically authorized by federal or state law.

SUMMARY

8 This bill prohibits a telephone utility from including line-item charges on telephone bills, 9 except those that represent actual services requested by a customer or that are specifically 10 required by federal or state law.
