Ĭ	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §1125, sub-§2-B is enacted to read:
3	2-B. Political action committee participation prohibited. A participating
4	candidate may not solicit contributions from, accept money for or otherwise participate ir
5	a political action committee, as defined in section 1052, subsection 5, established to
6	influence the election or defeat of legislative candidates or to support that candidate's
7	effort to be elected to a legislative leadership position.
8	SUMMARY
9	This bill prohibits Maine Clean Election Act candidates from participating in political
0	action committees that are established to influence the election or defeat of legislative
1	candidates or to support that candidate's effort to be elected to a legislative leadership
2	position.
