## An Act To Modify the Maine Dental Education Loan Program

(EMERGENCY)

Submitted by the Finance Authority of Maine pursuant to Joint Rule 204.

- Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
- 3 Whereas, the Maine Dental Education Loan Program is limited to 3 combined 4 awards annually and an aggregate of 12; and
- 5 Whereas, money in the program is currently sufficient to fund additional awards; 6 and
- Whereas, that money could be awarded in 2009 but for the current limitation and, if
  the limitation were eliminated in time to make awards to eligible students entering dental
  school in 2009, more students could benefit; and
- 10 Whereas, there is an urgent need in the State of Maine for additional dentists 11 practicing primary dentistry, which this program addresses by providing financial support 12 for dental students and certain dental practitioners; and
- Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,
- 17 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
- 18 Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §12302, sub-§1, as repealed and replaced by PL 2003, c.
   19 510, Pt. E, §1, is amended to read:
- 20 1. Establishment. The Maine Dental Education Loan Program, referred to in this chapter as "the program," is established. The authority shall administer the program. 21 22 Under this program, beginning in fiscal year 2000-01 and ending in fiscal year 2007-08, the chief executive officer shall award up to 3 loans or loan repayment agreements. 23 24 annually up to an aggregate of 12. Beginning in fiscal year 2008-09, the chief executive 25 officer shall award up to 3 loans or loan repayment agreements annually and may award 26 additional loans or loan repayment agreements annually as funds permit. As provided in 27 subsection 3:
- A. Loans are available to Maine residents enrolled in a dental school; or
- B. A loan repayment agreement is available to a person who is eligible for licensure
  as a doctor of dental medicine in Maine and who has outstanding dental education
  loans.
- 32 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this 33 legislation takes effect when approved.

## SUMMARY

This bill allows the Finance Authority of Maine to make more than 3 loans or loan repayment agreements annually under the Maine Dental Education Loan Program if funds permit.

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
