The Constitution of Maine 20 requires the reapportionment to be done within 120 days of convening of the Legislature, 21 which puts the date for reapportionment sometime in March, prior to receiving the 22 apportionment data. This amendment changes the date for Maine to do the reapportionment to June 1st, 23 24 after receipt of the reapportionment data.
