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SUMMARY

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This resolve is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

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5 This resolve proposes to establish a commission to support, preserve and maintain
6 Maine monuments at the Civil War battlefield in Gettysburg, Pennsylvania. The
7 commission is to include a former Governor of the State, 2 former state Legislators, 4
8 state Legislators, 2 of whom are Senators and 2 of whom are members of the House of
9 Representatives. The commission must also include 3 members who are veterans of the
10 United States Armed Forces and one member who is a member of an organization that
11 represents veterans of the United States Armed Forces. The commission is allowed to
seek outside funding to implement its mission.
