1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and
3 allocations are made.

4 **ADMINISTRATIVE AND FINANCIAL SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF**
5 **Miscellaneous Acts and Resolves**

6 Initiative: Provides funds to reimburse Philip Wolley for attorney's fees, expenses and
7 interest based on the rate charged by the Maine Public Employees Retirement System for
8 the reinstatement of past service credits.

15 This bill makes a one-time General Fund appropriation of \$28,000 in fiscal year
16 2009-10 to reimburse Philip Wolley for litigation expenses incurred in connection with
