COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 244, L.D. 308, Bill, "An Act To Clarify Standards by Which Game Wardens May Stop All-terrain Vehicles"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

**'An Act To Clarify Standards by Which All-terrain Vehicles May Be Stopped'**

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph G in the last line (page 1, line 10 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "13152" the following: ' Other law enforcement officers are subject to the provisions of this paragraph'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, clarifies that the reasonable and articulable suspicion standard for all-terrain vehicle stops applies to all law enforcement officers and not just game wardens.
