HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 244, L.D. 308, Bill, "An Act To Clarify Standards by Which Game Wardens May Stop All-terrain Vehicles"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §10353, sub-§2, ¶G, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 414, Pt. A, §2 and affected by c. 614, §9, is repealed.'

SUMMARY

This amendment repeals the provision of law relating specifically to the powers of game wardens to stop and examine all-terrain vehicles.
