1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2067, sub-§1, ¶C**, as enacted by PL 1997, c. 249, §1, is
3 amended to read:

4 C. At any time when ~~windshield wipers are in constant use~~ there are atmospheric
5 conditions unfavorable to visibility, including, but not limited to, rain, freezing rain,
6 fog and snow.

7 **SUMMARY**

8 This bill requires that a motor vehicle's headlights must be on during atmospheric
9 conditions unfavorable to visibility.
