4	C. At any time when windshield wipers are in constant use there are atmospheric
5	conditions unfavorable to visibility, including, but not limited to, rain, freezing rain
6	fog and snow.
7	SUMMARY
8	This bill requires that a motor vehicle's headlights must be on during atmospheric
9	conditions unfavorable to visibility.
