SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 104, L.D. 340, Bill, "An Act To Provide Greater Access to ATVs by Lowering the Minimum Operating Age"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 3 in the 3rd and 4th lines (page 1, lines 7 and 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "~~has successfully completed a training course approved by the department pursuant to section 13152 and~~" and inserting the following: 'has successfully completed a training course approved by the department pursuant to section 13152 and'

This amendment retains the reference in current law to the requirement that certain ATV operators successfully complete an ATV training program.
