1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §12460-A, sub-§3, as amended by PL 2007, c. 651, §12, is repealed.
4	Sec. 2. Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife; study. The
5	Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall study the feasibility of allowing
6	smelting on Ouellette Brook and Paulette Brook on Long Lake in Aroostook County
7	The department shall report its findings and recommendations to the Joint Standing
8	Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife by February 1, 2010. The Joint Standing
9	Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife may submit legislation based on the report to
10	the Second Regular Session of the 124th Legislature.
11	SUMMARY
12	Current law allows smelting on Mud Brook on Long Lake in Aroostook County unti
13	July 1, 2012. This bill allows smelting on Mud Brook beyond July 1, 2012. The bill also
14	directs the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to study the feasibility o
15	allowing smelting on Ouellette Brook and Paulette Brook on Long Lake in Aroostool
16	County.
