1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §15213, first ¶, as amended by PL 2001, c. 573, Pt. B, §20 and
3	affected by §36, is further amended to read:
4	A person may not service, repair, alter or install any elevator unless that person is
5	licensed as an elevator or lift mechanic under this chapter. Elevator work in industrial
6	plants and manufacturing plants may be performed by plant personnel who are not
7	licensed under this chapter if the work is supervised by the plant engineer and performed
8	in compliance with rules adopted by the board.
9	SUMMARY
10	This bill requires that work on elevators in industrial and manufacturing plants must
11	be done by a person that is licensed as an elevator or lift mechanic.
