COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 115, L.D. 351, Bill, "An Act Regarding the Regulation of Agricultural Composting Operations"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'Resolve, Authorizing Legislation Relating to Agricultural Composting Operations'

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. Authority to submit legislation. Resolved: That the Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry and the Joint Standing Committee on Natural Resources are authorized to submit legislation relating to the regulation of agricultural composting operations to the Second Regular Session of the 124th Legislature.'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the minority report. The amendment replaces the bill with a resolve and changes the title. It authorizes the Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry and the Joint Standing Committee on Natural Resources to submit legislation relating to the regulation of agricultural composting operations to the Second Regular Session of the 124th Legislature.
