Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §6323, sub-§3 is enacted to read:

3. Extension of deadline. Upon a showing of good cause, the court may extend a deadline established by this section for the publication of the notice of sale or conducting the public sale.

SUMMARY

This bill allows a court upon a showing of good cause to extend a deadline for a notice of sale or conducting a public sale in a foreclosure action.
