SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 292,
L.D. 385, Bill, "An Act To Ensure a Uniform Comprehensive State Policy Regarding
Residency Restrictions for Sex Offenders"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §3013 by inserting after subsection 2 the
following:

3. Exception. Notwithstanding subsection 1, this section does not apply to a
municipal ordinance or bylaw that is in effect on the effective date of this section.
