2	Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §3013 is enacted to read:
3	§3013. Prohibition on ordinance regarding residency restrictions for sex offenders
4 5	A municipality may not adopt an ordinance restricting where a person required to register under Title 34-A, chapter 15 may reside.
5	SUMMARY
7 3 9	This bill prohibits municipalities from adopting ordinances regarding residency restrictions for persons required to register as 10-year or lifetime registrants under the Sex Offender Registration and Notification Act of 1999.
