2 3	Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §243, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1999, c. 208, §1, is further amended to read:

To audit all accounts and other financial records of State Government or any department or agency of State Government, including the Maine Turnpike Authority, the judiciary and the Executive Department of the Governor, except the Governor's Expense Account, and to report annually on this audit, and at such other times as the Legislature may require;
9	Sec. 2. 23 MRSA §1974, sub-§7 is enacted to read:
10 11	7. Annual audit. The authority shall submit to an annual audit by the State Auditor to determine compliance with this section.
12	A. Any costs associated with the audit must be borne by the authority.
13 14	B. Notwithstanding section 1982, the authority shall disclose information in accordance with Title 5, section 244-C.
15	SUMMARY
16 17 18	This bill requires that the Maine Turnpike Authority submit to an annual audit by the State Auditor to determine compliance with the law governing the use of turnpike revenues.
