COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 305, L.D. 417, Bill, "An Act To Require State Employees To Pay 15% of Their Health Insurance Costs"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Require State Employees To Pay 10% of Their Health Insurance Costs'

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 7 in the 5th and 6th lines (page 1, lines 8 and 9 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "effective July 1, 2010, 90% of the premium; and effective July 1, 2011, 85% of the premium" and inserting the following: 'and effective July 1, 2011, 90% of the premium'

Amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the following:

'Sec. 3. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

Initiative: Reduces funding from savings resulting from reducing the state share of the individual health insurance premium for state employees from 100% to 95% effective October 1, 2009 and to 90% effective July 1, 2011.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill includes a General Fund deappropriation of \$1,639,866 in fiscal year 2009-10 and \$2,318,958 in fiscal year 2010-11 as a result of reducing the state share of the individual health insurance premium for state employees from 100% to 95% effective October 1, 2009 and 90% effective July 1, 2011. It also includes a Highway Fund deallocation of \$654,138 in fiscal year 2009-10 and \$923,982 in fiscal year 2010-11. The reduction in spending for employee health insurance premiums paid by other funds may allow for a decrease in allocations as recommended by the State Budget Officer and approved by the Governor.
